

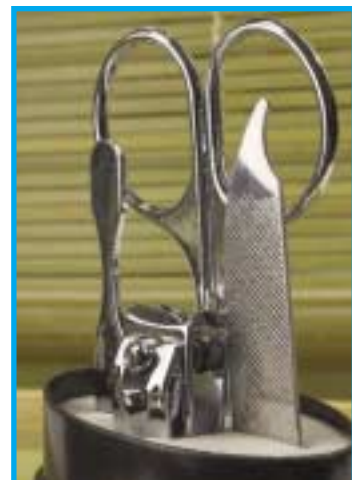

## HOW TO USE PEDI-GIENE

PEDI-GIENE is a hospital-use disinfectant used to clean and disinfect washable, hard, non-porous surfaces of: whirlpool units, salon/barber tools and instruments, combs, brushes, scissors, blades and manicure instruments. It is a proven one-step disinfectant-cleaner-fungicide-bactericide and virucide. PEDI-GIENE meets all states regulatory agencies' criteria.

After the customer has used the pedicure tub, the following steps can be taken:

1. Fill pedicure tub with fresh water to 2 inches above the highest jet.
2. Add 1oz. of this product for each gallon of fresh water added.
3. Start the pump to circulate the solution.
4. Wash down the deck, seat of chair lift and any uncovered surfaces with a clean swab, brush or sponge with the solution.
5. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes.
6. After the pedicure foot spa has been thoroughly disinfected, drain and rinse surfaces with fresh water.
7. Wipe dry with a clean sponge or cloth, or allow to air dry.
8. Repeat for heavily soiled units.



General disinfection of hard, non-porous surfaces: Mix 1oz. of this product per gallon of water (1/4 oz. of this product per 32 oz. spray bottle). Contact time: Leave surface wet for one minute for Human Immunodeficiency Virus Type 1 (HIV-1) and 10 minutes for Hepatitis B Virus (HBV) and Hepatitis C Virus (HCV) with a 1oz. per gallon use. Use a 10 minute contact time for disinfection against all other viruses, bacteria and fungi claimed.

Salon/barber instruments and tools disinfection (bactericide/virucide/fungicide) directions: Mix 2 oz. of this product per gallon of water, 0.5 oz. of this product per quart of water, to disinfect hard, non-porous instruments and tools. Completely immerse combs, brushes, rollers, manicure and other salon instruments and tools for 10 minutes. For heavily soiled instruments and tools, a preliminary cleaning is required. Rinse thoroughly and dry before use. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or more often if solution becomes diluted or soiled. Note: Plastics may remain immersed until ready to use. Stainless steel shears and instruments must be removed after 10 minutes, rinsed, dried and kept in a clean, non-contaminated receptacle. Prolonged soaking may cause damage to metal instruments.
